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BATHCREST of SEATTLE CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

For best results and to insure compliance with our 5-year warrantee, please read and follow this entire care and maintenance sheet.

Your bathtub may be used 48 hours after the finish was applied. However, the surface will not be completely cured for 30 days.

Do not leave any bottles or bars of soaps on the ledges of your tub. Always avoid trapping water against the surface for long periods of time because moisture gets trapped underneath and eats away the Glazecote over time.

Shower caddies hung from the showerhead are recommended as an alternative way to store essentials.

Do not leave bathmats, wet towels or rugs hanging over the side of the tub.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

Keep Porcelain or Fiberglass Surfaces in Top Condition:

- **Throw away all your abrasive, gritty substance, scouring powder cleaners.** They are the biggest offenders in bath maintenance.
- **Clean the surface two or three times a week with liquid cleaners,** such as Dawn Dish Liquid, Palmolive, Joy or dish liquid. If you have a problem with soap buildup, mix baking soda with dish liquid to dissolve the buildup.
- **Always rinse the tub thoroughly after cleanings.** Please do not use any product sprayed from an aerosol can or any product that is not recommended for refinished surfaces. Avoid all products containing bleach. Avoid all products that are sprayed on and not rinsed off immediately.
- **A nylon bath lufa is recommended for scrubbing the tub surface.** This can be found in the soap department of the grocery store. Nylon lufa's are ideal for cleaning purposes because they are soft and do not scratch the tub surface.
- **Cleaned regularly, two to three times a week.** Remove greasy soap build-up even if it does not appear dirty, to. Train your family to wipe down the surface after each use, especially if there are any areas where water stands or puddles. Standing or pudding water will create undo wear and cause mineral deposits to collect when the water evaporates.

Drain Pan Cleaning:

- Clean out hair and debris from under the strainer.
- Pour one cup of baking soda down the drain.
- Follow with one cup of white vinegar down the drain.
- Follow with one cup of white vinegar and 1/2 gallon of boiling water.
- Repeat until drain clears.

Mineral Deposits:

- Carefully remove unsightly spots on your fixtures
- Soak for 20 minutes in white vinegar.
- Brush deposits loose with a tooth brush.

Once a week, a sponge dipped in white vinegar is the ideal treatment for cleaning glass shower doors. Lemon oil will remove most water spots on the metal frame enclosure.

If there is soap build-up, trying spraying your shower door or ceramic tile with any prewash spray. After spraying the surface, wait a few moments and then rub down with a damp sponge. Do not use prewash spray on the fiberglass surface.

Bathmats:

If you find that your new finish is slippery, use a non-suction type bathmat. The suction type mat will harm your new surface. We are able to order you a warranty approved bathmat. You may not leave ANY bathmat on the tub for an extended period of time. If you use a bathmat, please take it out of the tub after use. Do not set the bathmat over the side of the bathtub.

Leaking Faucets:

Dripping water will wear through the hardest of surfaces. Make sure that your plumbing problems are fixed immediately. Constant dripping water can wear down the surface and leave mineral deposits that cause damage to the surface.
